- An overwhelming sense of God's presence during your quiet time?
- An unexpected financial provision?
- Attaining a goal?
- Understanding of a Scripture passage that has always been puzzling?
- Strength to do a very hard thing?
- Ability to accomplish a task?
- Protection from a near-miss accident?
- Sustaining grace to persevere and endure a difficult time? A mundane time?
- Wisdom in a crisis/important decision?

- \* Confidence that you were making the right decision?
- \* A health issue resolved?
- Ability to forgive an extreme hurt?
- ❖ An unexpected opportunity to share your faith
- An uncanny way a situation or event unfolded
